



Octava Fike Missions Scholarship for West Texas Students at SNU

The West Texas District NMI has established a scholarship fund from which it will annually award a scholarship of up to \$1,000 to a worthy student(s). The requirements are that the student(s) must:

1. Be a participating member of a local Church of the Nazarene on the West Texas District.
2. Be entering his/her junior or senior year of college at Southern Nazarene University and preparing for a career in Nazarene World Missions.
3. Maintain a minimum cumulative grade point of 3.0. (The scholarship will be paid directly to SNU each semester after grades are verified.)
4. Must submit the following items to the District NMI President **on or before January 1** for receipt of scholarship for fall term:
 - a. A letter of recommendation from the applicant's pastor or local NMI president
 - b. A letter of recommendation from a professor, counselor, or chaplain at SNU
5. The candidate must participate in a personal interview conducted by the scholarship committee at the district NMI convention or at a time scheduled by the scholarship committee.

All qualifications are subject to review by the West Texas Scholarship Committee.

Financial need may be a consideration of the scholarship committee.

REMEMBER THAT APPLICATIONS ARE DUE BY JANUARY 1.
